

COVID BOOSTER VACCINES FAQS

How long do I need to wait after getting a flu vaccine before getting a COVID vaccine?

It is not necessary to wait a specified amount of time between getting these two vaccines.

Can my child get a COVID vaccine at CWC?

At this time, COVID boosters at CWC are available to employees and spouses only.

Can my spouse get a COVID vaccine at CWC?

Yes, with a qualifying condition. [List of Qualifying Conditions](#)

Are retirees eligible to receive the COVID boosters at CWC?

At this time, the COVID boosters at CWC are available to current employees and spouses only.

How long must I wait after my last COVID vaccine?

6 months

How long must I wait after having COVID 19 or receiving Monoclonal Antibodies?

90 days

Can I get a flu vaccine at CWC during the COVID booster event?

No, COVID booster vaccines will be the only service provided on Nov. 6th.

What if I got the Moderna COVID vaccine series initially?

At this time, CWC is providing the Pfizer booster vaccine to those who received the Pfizer vaccine series initially.

What if I don't have my vaccine card?

Without a vaccine card, you will not be eligible to receive a COVID booster at CWC. Please contact the provider who gave you the initial series of COVID vaccines for a replacement card.

Do I have to have the district insurance to be eligible to receive a COVID vaccine at CWC?

No

Can I catch COVID from the COVID booster vaccine?

No

What are the side effects of the COVID booster vaccine?

Pain at the injection site, tiredness, headache, muscle pain, chills, joint pain, and fever. Symptoms generally resolve in 1-2 days.
